Part 1.

Have a look at the cookie management capabilities of your favourite browser.

Part 2.

Implement a webpage that displays the type of browser that is used to access the page using PHP.

Hint: Use \$_SERVER['HTTP_USER_AGENT']

Part 3.

Implement a webpage that displays the type of browser and also counts the number of times it is visited using a cookie in PHP.

The important command is setcookie(name, value, expiry)

Individual cookies can be accessed using the syntax: \$_COOKIE['name'];

Store the counter as a variable called \$counter

Part 4.

Implement a webpage that displays the type of browser and also counts the number of times it is visited using session management in PHP

To start a session, call the function session_start() and then register a variable in the \$_SESSION array.
